
The landscape around someone in a portrait tells us where they liked to spend time. Draw a portrait of yourself and make the background look like a place where you spend a lot of time.

These works of art can tell us what a person looked like, the important things they did, where they lived, and how other people felt about them. Use this guide to help you explore portraits at the Rubin Museum of Art.




Activity No. 1

Borrow a magnifying glass from near the stairs. Use it to look at patterns on the clothes people are wearing in portraits. *Draw your favorite design here.*

A person's hand gestures can tell us about the important things he did. If someone's hands look like this, we know he was a teacher because this is the gesture of teaching in Tibetan portraits. *Find a portrait of a teacher and draw him in the space above.*

Some portraits show people with strange hair or a special hat. Others show a person's particular facial features, like a big smile or wide-open eyes. These things help tell us who is being portrayed. *Draw one of the unusual features you see in a portrait*.
